## Ben Beachy Director, Living Economy Program Sierra Club

Ben Beachy has worked to transform economic policies for over 15 years in organizations advocating for workers' rights, climate and racial justice, and public health. At the Sierra Club, he founded the Living Economy program to build cross-movement backing for trade, industrial, infrastructure, and stimulus policies that simultaneously create good jobs, tackle climate change, and curb racial, economic, and gender inequity. Ben also has served as research director for Public Citizen's Global Trade Watch in DC, analyzed the impacts of U.S. trade and aid policies in Nicaragua, written on the financial crisis with the Global Development and Environment Institute in Boston, researched climate impacts with ActionAid in India, and investigated labor abuses with the Worker Rights Consortium in Honduras. Ben received a Master in Public Policy from Harvard's Kennedy School of Government, where he was a Public Service Fellow. Ben hails from West Virginia and is rooted in DC.
